

DEADLINES AND TUITION FEES

STUDY PLAN

The study plan includes all the educational activities that must be carried out to obtain the degree. During the compilation, the student chooses the courses of their choice based on those available and offered in the various degree programs. The individual plan can be changed online according to the rules established by each faculty and course of study by accessing the student's Reserved Area. It can be modified until November 30 thereafter, a penalty of €50.00 is incurred. (except for the Faculty of Medicine where it can be only modified in the final year).


PART-TIME

Students currently enrolled (with the exception of those enrolled in all courses at the Faculty of Medicine, the Building and Architecture course, the Land Management and Techniques course, and the Industrial Information Systems course) have the option to enroll part-time. This particular type of enrollment allows for a 50% discount on the second and third installments, with the possibility of taking up to a maximum of 30 CFU credits.

Essentially, each academic year is split into two part-time years. This status is acquired for a minimum of two consecutive years and for a maximum number of years equal to twice the normal duration of the course of study. Part-time students with an ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) lower than €25,000 are eligible for a full exemption if they have completed 5 CFU credits for the 1st year and 12 for subsequent years."

I have applied for the ERDIS scholarship, do I need to communicate my ISEE to UNIVPM?

Yes, it is advisable to provide consent for the acquisition of the ISEE from the INPS database (unless you have already done so last year), because if you are not included in the scholarship ranking or in case of future revocation of the scholarship, you will be required to pay the 2nd and 3rd installments of the fees. Therefore, if you do not give your consent, the amounts will be maximum; otherwise, they will be calculated based on your actual income.

You have until November 6, 2023, to give your consent to access the INPS database within your reserved area Esse3 Web, in the section 'Personal Data' » 'Consents.'

I am a graduating student of the bachelor's degree in the December/February session, what should I do to enroll in the master's program conditionally?

It is possible for graduating students in the

December/February session conditional enrollment for the master's degree. Each faculty has its own regulations for enrolling in master's degrees with different methods and deadlines. The regulations can be found on the University's website, in the 'Student Services' section » Student Secretariat of your own faculty » Enrollment in Master's Degree Programs » ADMISSION RULES.

If I graduate within the extraordinary session (March/April), do I have to pay the fees for the academic year 2023/2024? No, if you apply for graduation within the extraordinary session, you are in good standing with the payment of the fees for the academic year 2022/2023. If you do not graduate, please consult the Student Secretariat to find out how to proceed with the payment of the fees without any additional charges. We suggest you fill out the Application for Reductions/Exemptions for any possible benefits.

Is it possible to modify the study plan during the year? The study plan must be submitted by 30/11/2023. If the student has specific needs to modify their plan after this date, they can do so by submitting a specific form to the secretariat, available on the University's website, on the page related to the secretariat of their own Faculty/Department. Once approved by the Course Council (as soon as it is convened), the student will see their study plan modified in their reserved area on ESSE3 web. In this case, a fee of €50.00 will be applied, payable exclusively through the PagoPA system (contact the secretariat for uploading the fee to the reserved area).

How can I obtain certificates related to my academic career (enrollment, degree, exams taken, payments)?

In cases where a simple paper submission is sufficient, such as for accessing scholarships from various institutions, you need to access the 'Secretary' section on ESSE3 web » Certificates.

Is it possible to have the exams I have already taken at other universities recognized?

Yes. You can request a transfer from another institution using the appropriate form available on the University's website (student services » student secretariats » faculty/department » forms), while checking the deadline for doing so.

Through the University Sports Center (CUS), UNIVPM promotes the practice of sports activities for all university students. COMPUTER LABS

UNIVPM provides students with PC labs within each Faculty or Department, equipped with multiple devices that can be accessed by using your university credentials. Additionally, a free printing service is offered to all students. Upon enrollment at the University, you are allocated 150 printing credits, with an additional 20 credits added on the first of each month. Black and white printers are available in the labs, with A3 and A4 paper formats. You can print in any of the computer labs, regardless of your enrolled faculty.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AND SLD

The Polytechnic University of the Marche offers a dedicated service for students with disabilities and/or specific learning disorders (SLD). To access this service, it is necessary to report your situation at the time of enrollment or when renewing your registration to the relevant Student Office.

You should provide the required certification (disability, disability, or SLD diagnostic certification not exceeding three years from the date of issuance if obtained before the age of 18).

PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT SERVICE

For several years, there has been an active free listening and psychological support service for all students enrolled at the Polytechnic University of the Marche. The psychological support service is a counseling and support service aimed at promoting the well-being of the young students enrolled in various faculties, providing a dedicated space for reception and listening. Thanks to a proposal from our Gulliver Representation List, presented last year to the Single Guarantee Committee, the personnel dedicated to the service has been increased to meet the growing demand from the student body.

VIRTUAL ANTI-VIOLENCE DESK

Starting from June 2023, UNIVPM has launched a virtual anti-violence service in the form of an anonymous chat, accessible to all students through their Reserved Area. Once logged in, all students need to do is go to the "CUG - Single Guarantee Committee for Equal Opportunities" section and click on "Virtual Anti-Violence Desk." This will grant them access to the Rompi il Silenzio platform, which is exclusively managed by operators from the Women and Justice Association.

The service is not intended to handle emergency situations but to provide initial contact and support .

CARRIERA ALIAS

For students who wish, it is possible to activate the Alias Career for internal procedures of the University. The Alias Career will allow you to enroll online for university exams and to have a booklet/card to access university services using your chosen name.

The request to activate "CARRIERA ALIAS" must be sent to the email address didattica@univpm.it, attaching the request form (available on the page www.univpm.it » "Services and Opportunities" » "CARRIERA ALIAS") and the documentation attesting to the psychological and/or medical path aimed at the possible rectification of the gender in the registry. We are working so that the activation request no longer needs to be accompanied by documentation certifying gender dysphoria, as the psychological and/or medical process is often inaccessible, very expensive, and requires lengthy procedures.

PARKING

- **Monte Dago:** free
- **Economics:** you have to request a permit

and the magnetic badge for identification at the Student Office of the Faculty of Economics. The permit costs €10 and must be renewed annually.

- **Medicine:** It is necessary to request a permit and the activation of the badge, which you already have, for attendance monitoring at the Student Office of the Faculty of Medicine. The permit is free.

These range from presenting the Study Plan to paying University Fees, and from Booking Exams to accessing the Notice Board for results. From here, you can consult all the data related to your academic career and check the payments,

your online record book, alongside the available exam sessions. Through the portal, you can also fill out the evaluation questionnaires. Furthermore, it is possible to participate in various scholarship competitions offered by the University as well as student collaborations and other opportunities in general.

Regarding the Reserved Area (located at the top of the Univpm website next to ESSE3 Web), this section includes several online services provided by our University, such as event booking, laboratory access safety courses, the Virtual Anti-violence Desk, and other services.

By downloading the "MyUnivpm" application (available for all operating systems), which was obtained through our representation efforts, you can easily access your Reserved Area from your smartphone.

E-LEARNING (MOODLE)

Through the platform www.learn.univpm.it students can access educational materials provided by the faculty by entering their credentials. By referring to the academic year of enrollment and their course of study, students can view the list of various subjects. Clicking on a course allows access to teaching materials provided by the instructors, which can range from PowerPoint presentations and in-depth videos to self-assessment quizzes. WI-FI

At all faculties, common areas accessible to students and some classrooms are equipped with antennas for Wi-Fi coverage. To access the service (free and unlimited), you need to enter your credentials, using the specific methods of the University's Wi-Fi network, which are the same as those for the reserved area (Student ID and associated password)

HELPDESK ONLINE

Our university has set up a Help Desk service aimed at students for resolving their issues in using all online services, to which they can submit a ticket with the problem encountered. JOB OPPORTUNITIES

PART-TIME (150 ORE)

The university offers students enrolled in study courses, who meet the requirements specified in the competition announcement, starting from the second year, the opportunity to carry out collaboration activities with the University for a maximum of 150 hours

It is a part-time collaboration, through which the student is involved within the University's facilities, such as libraries, laboratories, administration, and archives, for a compensation of 8 euros per hour. The call is published annually on the University's website (Student Services »Scholarships and opportunities »Part-time student collaboration), and it generally expires in the month of January.

ATTENTION: To get information about the release of the call, stay updated by following our Facebook page and the University's homepage.

The application is completed exclusively online through your reserved area. At the end of the call, a ranking list will be drawn up, taking into account the student's merit and income requirements. TUTORING

The tutoring program is a support initiative for educational activities organized by all faculties and departments, in collaboration with selected students through specific calls for applications. The activities carried out by the students include: assistance in individual study, support for laboratory activities

up to a maximum of 200 hours.

MATRICOLARE: This role involves guiding first-year students, explaining the main mechanisms of university functioning, such as schedules, study plans, and exam registration.

IN ITINERE: The in-process guide helps in the recovery of critical situations and increases the success rate in passing exams, in coordination with discipline-specific tutors.

DISCIPLINARE: Conducts activities related to specific skills in certain training activities.

GUIDA: Accompanies first-year students in the transition from school to university, supporting them in passing first-year exams in coordination with discipline-specific tutors.

Students enrolled in the following programs can apply for the tutoring position: Master's degree courses; The last three years of Single-Cycle Master's degree courses (from the 4th year onwards for the Medicine and Surgery course); The third year of Bachelor's degree courses and have obtained at least 80 CFUs at the time of signing the tutoring contract.

However, it should be noted that if a graduation application is submitted, automatic exclusion from the list occurs.

To participate in the selection, the candidate is required to submit an application, within the specified deadline, through the dedicated online procedure accessible from their reserved area on ESSE3web.

The merit rankings consider only the qualifications for all faculties, except for engineering, where students are also selected through an evaluative interview.

The rankings will be published on the University's website, under the "STUDENT SERVICES" and "TUTORING ACTIVITIES" section.

The scholarships are compatible with the use of study grants, while they are incompatible with part-time collaborations of 150 hours related to the same academic year and with enrollment as a part-time student. The hourly compensation is €12.00 gross, including the charges payable by the recipient.

INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY

The UNIVPM offers various exchange programs with other institutions abroad. These projects aim to carry out various activities at different stages of one's academic career, such as studying, internships, and thesis preparation.

The duration of these projects can vary, ranging from a minimum of 2 months (3 months for study purposes) up to

12 months and offer a monthly scholarship of varying amounts depending on the project, the student's ISEE, and the weighted average. The UnivPM website has a dedicated section that gathers all these opportunities. (Home Page » International » Opportunities Abroad » Students). There are several calls for applications to participate in, each with different deadlines, generally falling under the Erasmus+ Project.

ERASMUS+

This is an exceptional opportunity primarily provided by the European Union and falls within programs aimed at promoting international mobility and cultural exchange among member countries and other partner states. The call provides for a maximum duration of 12 months for bachelor's/master's degree courses, while for single-cycle degree courses, a maximum of 24 months of international mobility is provided. Such an experience is an opportunity to broaden not only one's academic knowledge but also cultural and linguistic horizons, giving an international touch to one's curriculum. TRAINEESHIP AND CAMPUSWORLD

Our University offers several specific international mobility projects dedicated to internships: Erasmus Traineeship and CampusWorld.

The price of a full meal for students who do not have the application or have not authenticated is €9.00.

Prices for non-scholarship students:

Full meal (€5.50): one first course, one main course, one side dish, two rolls, fruit, drinks.

Reduced meal (without first or second course, €3.30): one first course or one main course, one side dish, one roll, a choice of fruit, yogurt, or juice, drinks.

Supplements: mozzarella, yogurt, extra side dish, dessert.

FREE MEDICAL SERVICE

After years of advocating, our List has obtained a free healthcare service for all the non-local students, who were previously forced to expensive temporary solutions or to forgo the service altogether in their hometown. The Service is funded by ERDIS, and the doctors

provide general consultancy and outpatient visits, without the ability to prescribe specialist visits or laboratory tests. It is not possible to request home visits or visits to university college rooms through this Medical Service.

To benefit from the free Medical Service, it will be sufficient to present a valid university identification document, and then fill in and sign a self-declaration of residency, enrollment, and the completion of the visit.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT AND PARKING

Every student regularly enrolled at UNVIPM can benefit from discounts for the purchase of public transportation passes and for a parking service in the Municipality of Ancona

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

In the city of Ancona, through the local transport company ATMA, in collaboration with UNIVPM, it is possible to request a discounted rate subscription.

You can subscribe to various types of urban subscriptions:

- **"ALFA"**: valid from October 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, for an amount of €130
- **"ALFA BIS"**: valid from September 1, 2023, to May 31, 2024, for an amount of €130
- **"BETA"**: valid from October 1, 2023, to September 30, 2024, for an amount of €150
- **"BETA BIS"**: valid from September 1, 2023, to August 31, 2024, for an amount of €150
- **"OMEGA"**: 1st part valid from October 1, 2023, to December 31, 2023, for an amount of €75. 2nd part valid from January 1, 2024, to June 30, 2024, for an amount of €75.

N.B: it is not possible to purchase the second part without having purchased the first

Suburban bus pass:

- **"GAMMA"**: urban + suburban **18 km**, from **October 1st 2023** to **June 30th 2024**, cost **€250**
- **"DELTA"**: urban + suburban **36 km**, valido dal **October 1st 2023** to **June 30th 2024** , cost **€300**

Politecnica Link: To facilitate access to the UNIVPM university campuses, a direct transport service has been activated between the Ancona Central Station, Passo Varano Station, and the Monte Dago university campus, as well as between the Central Station and the Torrette Station with the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery. The schedules of the lines have been set to coincide with the trains stopping at the railway stations. The service is available on weekdays from Monday to Friday.

Medical Link: This service coordinates Regional trains, Frecce, and Intercity trains arriving at the Ancona and Ancona Torrette stations with buses heading directly to the Ancona Torrette university campus. With a single train+bus travel ticket purchasable through all Trenitalia sales channels (Trenitalia.com, App, ticket offices, self-service, affiliated points of sale, and travel agencies), you can comfortably avail of daily connections to and from the "Ancona Polo Ospedaliero Universitario" location. In the Trenitalia ticket booking platform, simply enter "Ancona Polo Ospedaliero Universitario" as the arrival station to connect all of Italy directly to the Medicine campus.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Gulliver-University Left has always paid special attention to issues related to student rentals in the city of Ancona.

Although the average cost of a bed is quite reasonable, especially when compared to other university areas, this does not mean that transparency and legality reign in the world of Ancona rentals. However, a **regular rental contract** is the only tool that allows students to protect their rights in terms of leasing, in case of disputes or misunderstandings with the landlord!

Renting a bed off the books is not only illegal but also exposes you to the risk of being left without accommodation at any time and to the possibility that the homeowner may decide to increase the rent at their own discretion. It does not protect you in the distribution of expenses.

Law no. 431/1998 on rentals introduced a specific type of agreed rental contract for university students. It is a type of transitional contract dedicated to those studying in a different municipality from their residence, which is very convenient for both the tenant and the homeowner.

This contract not only allows the student to rent a bed at controlled prices through specific territorial agreements but also provides tax benefits for both the tenant and the landlord.

Of course, these benefits and contributions presuppose the existence of a duly registered contract, as established in the local agreements deposited with the municipality. The expected contract duration is between 6 and 36 months, and it is automatically renewable in favor of the tenant, meaning that at the first expiration, the landlord cannot terminate it without a substantial notice.

UNIVERSITY CARD

ANCONA

Ancona does not yet, in terms of activities, venues, services, and opportunities for socializing, appear to be a truly student-friendly city.



However, our association tries to organize cultural and recreational activities throughout the year to make the most of the city. We recommend following us on social media to stay updated on the events we organize.

In addition to arranging cultural activities, aperitifs, and parties within the faculties throughout the year, as well as in our headquarters in Via Saffi and various locations in Ancona, we aim to ensure that the student is not merely a passerby but can become a true citizen, with the opportunity to discover and appreciate the place and every cultural event organized in the area, experiencing the city in its entirety.

WHAT TO VISIT IN ANCONA:

Mole Vanvitelliana: Formerly the city's lazaretto, built by Luigi Vanvitelli at the behest of the Pope. Its uniqueness lies in its pentagonal plan and the continuous references to this geometric shape within the monument, including the temple of St. Rocco, which stands in the inner courtyard. Inside, you'll find the Omero Tactile Museum and it serves as the venue for many cultural events, such as exhibitions, concerts, and an open-air cinema during the summer. Since 2022, it has hosted the GulliveRock Festival, organized annually by our association.

Palace of the Elders: Since the 13th century, it has been the ancient municipal seat of the city. It is a perfect example of medieval construction, both in terms of style and the materials used (white limestone from Conero).

Arch of Trajan: Erected by the Roman Senate in honor of the emperor. It stands as an excellent testament to the Roman period, thanks also to its perfect state of preservation. It is depicted in the Trajan's Column in Rome.

Museums: From a cultural perspective, Ancona offers several museums, including the Archaeological Museum, the City Art Gallery, the City Museum, and the previously mentioned Omero Museum.




Clementine Arch: A neoclassical work designed by Vanvitelli for Pope Clement XII. At the time, the structure was intended to overshadow the nearby Arch of Trajan and simultaneously create a unique entrance from the sea to the city.

Porta Pia: An ancient gateway to the city of Ancona. It was built between 1787 and 1789 by the will of Pope Pius VI. The part facing the sea is in perfect Baroque style, contrasting with the simple tuff rustication of the side facing Ancona and the walls connecting it to the Citadel.

Senate Square: The location of the ancient Roman forum; behind it stands the Roman Amphitheater, built in the Augustan age.

Fountain of Calamo, better known as the Fountain of the Thirteen Spouts: of ancient Greek origin, it was later reconstructed during the Renaissance, and numerous legends are associated with it.

Cathedral of St. Ciriaco: The city's cathedral, situated on the top of Guasco hill, offering a fantastic view of the harbor, is a fine example of Italian romanticism and an extraordinary testament to local art. The construction is characterized by the pink hues gifted by stones extracted from the local quarries.



Passetto: In this district, we find the “Monumento ai Caduti”, in memory of the victims of the First World War. The work is made of Istrian stone in a neoclassical style. From here, you can take the staircase or the elevator, which allows you to reach the beach and the caves below.

Parks: near the city center, we have "La Cittadella" (or Fortezza Sangallo), Pincio Park, where the Monument to the Ancona Resistance is located, Cardeto Park, whose entrance is next to Villarey, where the Lighthouse and the city's Jewish cemetery are located. Further out is the Posatora Park, accessible via the 3 line, which hosts cultural events during the summer.

Piazza del Plebiscito / del Papa (PdP): It is the oldest square in Ancona. Its shape is unique: it is rectangular and elongated; moreover, it is also notable that it has various levels connected by two ramps and staircases. It is the main venue for "University Wednesdays"!

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- **CULTURAL ACTIVITIES** on a wide range of different topics, featuring experts and university professors: healthcare in prisons, edible insects, eco-mafias, the role of women in Fascism, and many more.
- **EVENTS** such as aperitifs, board game nights, parties.
- **BUSES** for the Marche Pride and the May 1st Concert.

REPRESENTATIVES

Being a representative means becoming the spokesperson for the students.

This involves both assisting in the **small and large challenges** of university life, including exams, studying, difficulties with professors and bureaucratic procedures, as well as advocating for **significant achievements**, such as expanding the no-tax area and increasing the income threshold for access to scholarships.

The goal is always the same: to act in the best interests of the students and ensure that everyone, **regardless of their economic and social circumstances**, has access to high quality and affordable education.

HOW?

To become a student representative, one must run as a candidate with a List. Every two years at our University, student elections are held to renew the positions within the University's governing bodies. This is a crucial moment for the entire student community because during this occasion, we are called to elect those who will have the responsibility of interacting with the University's governance for the next two years. They will represent the voice of the students, bring forward proposals to improve university life, and ensure that the rights of all of us students are protected.



There are three things that make you a good person to others:

WHERE?

Student representatives carry out their role within the University's governing bodies. They are primarily divided into three types of bodies: **the Course Council, the Department Council, and the Student Council.**

The **Course Council** deals with issues related to their specific degree program, where proposals for changes that specifically concern the course of study are evaluated. Examples include moving a course from one semester to another or the overall organization of the study program.

The **Department Council** (CdD) addresses broader themes: the department includes various subject areas and makes decisions regarding that thematic area. For Sciences and Agriculture, the CdDs are the decision-making bodies for the entire Faculty and include all degrees; on the other hand, for Engineering, Economics, and Medicine, the representatives in the CdDs elect members of the Faculty Council.

The Faculty or Department Councils are the bodies where the most important decisions are made. They deliberate on potential changes to the faculty's educational regulations, approve academic calendars, and modify the overall structure of each degree program. In addition to this, they have veto power over decisions made in the Course Council.

If student representatives wish to increase the number of exam sessions within the Faculty, they would have to present a document to the Faculty Council and have it approved by its members.

The **Student Council (CS)** is the only body within the entire University composed exclusively of students from all faculties. The Student Council provides opinions on all decisions or bureaucratic practices made by the University and proposes changes or improvements that are in the interest of all university students. The CS also elects key figures within the University: the President of the Student Council, the student representatives in the Academic Senate (SA), and the Board of Directors (CdA).

The **President of the CS** represents all the students of the University and personally interacts with the Rector and the General Director.

The **SA (Academic Senate)** is the body that makes all the policy decisions related to the university, where the proposals of the CS are voted on, and where all decisions made in the 'minor' bodies are discussed. Finally, the **CdA (Board of Directors)** decides everything related to any investments that the University needs to undertake."

THE ROLE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Within the University, a representative commits to addressing **both the daily issues** that students may encounter, such as rescheduling an exam, talking to a professor, or navigating the complex university bureaucracy, as well as **bringing forward proposals or improvements aimed at making the University more student-friendly**. Through the representatives in the governing bodies, the voice of the students is brought to the attention of the institutions and decision-making councils of the University.

Without representatives, all decisions that have an impact on the student community would be made without it being heard.

Furthermore, students can propose significant improvements to the university system, ranging from changes to the tuition fee regulations, university regulations, or the organization of study programs.

Our commitment as representatives extends beyond university bodies. In fact, it's not just the university that plays a significant role in the university journey, but also other institutions such as the ERDIS (Ente Regionale Diritto allo Studio), the Municipality, and the Region.

The dedication that the representatives can put into improving students' lives covers issues related to the university environment and the Right to Study, as well as those concerning the everyday aspects of university life."

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

The student representatives have the fundamental role of ensuring that each of us is placed in the conditions to live their university journey as well as possible.

This journey is not only about classes and exams but represents a true moment of personal and cultural growth.

The importance of being a student representative becomes evident when your commitment succeeds in helping even one individual student.

STUDENT POLITICS

Gulliver is also student politics: connected to the cultural association, there is the List 'Gulliver - Sinistra Universitaria', a student representation list entirely independent from political parties and unions.

It is made up of students who identify with the political, social, and cultural values of the Left and is open to collaboration with students who align with its principles.

The representatives of students, elected every two years through student elections, are the voice of the students within Department, Faculty, and University bodies and they consistently advocate for the rights of university students on various levels."

UNIONE DEGLI UNIVERSITARI

Since 2008, we have been affiliated with the Unione degli Universitari (Union of University Students - UDU), a nation-wide confederation of student associations and unions with approximately 10,000 members each year.

UDU advocates daily for the **protection of students' rights**, tirelessly working within universities to create a system that ensures access to university education for those lacking means, promoting democracy and student participation.

Udu participates locally and nationally in the election of Student Representatives, with a high number of elected representatives in University and Faculty bodies.

Furthermore, UDU has elected members in the National Council of University Students and the National University Council.
